The Scottish Parliament
Pàrlamaid na h-Alba

An Act of the Scottish Parliament to amend the Climate Change (Scotland) Act 2009 to make provision setting targets for the reduction of greenhouse gases emissions and to make provision about advice, plans and reports in relation to those targets.

This section applies where the Scottish Ministers make regulations under either 1a of the following—(a) section 1a of the regulations, (b) section 1a(2), where the regulations are the second or subsequent regulations made under that section, (c) section 2A(1), modifying one or more of the percentage figures applying for the purposes of the target 15 (2) An annual target in relation to a year which is subsequent to the year in which the regulations mentioned in subsection (1) come into force is to be recalculated under section 3 and,

The Bill amends the Climate Change (Scotland) Act 2009 (“the 2009 Act”) to make provision setting targets for the reduction of greenhouse gases and plans and reports in relation to those targets. It should be read together with the 2009 Act with most of the Bill’s provisions inserting, amending or repealing text in that principal Act, the 2009 Act. For example, the regulation-making powers inserted into the 2009 Act by the Bill will be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the

I have to change my family physician

You can search for a family physician closer to your new residence on the homepage of the [Health Insurance Fund](#)!

In order to be entered into the practice list of a family physician, you have to submit an application to your new family physician. A separate application shall be submitted for each family member. If there are no available places in the practice list of the family physician, they will reply to you within 7 days.

The transfer to the list of a new family physician will take effect on the first day of the next calendar month.

How to find a suitable nursery school for my child?

You can choose a nursery school for your child from [municipal nursery schools](#) or private nursery schools if there are available places in your chosen nursery school.

If a child's registered residence is in the corresponding city or rural municipality, they are entitled to a place in a municipal nursery school.

When searching for a nursery school for your child, it would be wise to contact the education official of your local government who can explain to you the conditions for accepting a child into a nursery school and procedure for applying for a nursery school place.

My child must change schools

Be sure to look up early what your child's education possibilities in the new residence are. Contact the education official of the city or rural municipality government at the place that is going to be your residence to find a place in a school for your child. They will also tell you which documents you need to submit for the child to be accepted to the school.

If you want to choose a school for your child yourself, contact your chosen school and ask about available places.

Once you have found a place for your child in a new school, you need to submit an application to your child's current school to have the child deleted from its list.

Include your contact information (phone number, e-mail address) on the application for release from school so that the school could contact you, if necessary. Also include on the application the name and location of the new school where your child will continue their studies.

Forward the information of your new residence or your contact details to the local government for entry into the Population Register.

Am I obligated to notify the State about my change of residence?

You have an obligation pursuant to law to make sure your residence address in the Population Register is correct. When you are changing your residence in Estonia, relocating to a foreign country, or relocating from a foreign country to Estonia, you need to submit a notice of residence to register a new place of residence in the Population Register.

To enter residence data into the Population Register, the notice shall be submitted within 30 days to the city or rural municipality government of your place of residence, in Tallinn, to the corresponding city district government.
